

SOUTH SKYE MOTORHOME PARK - TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USE

By making a booking with South Skye Motorhome Park you are agreeing to the specific terms and conditions noted below. You are also agreeing to comply with any requests made to you by any An Crubh Ltd. and Camuscross and Duisdale Initiative employees while you are on the site.

Bookings

South Skye Motorhome Park only accepts bookings via our website portal.

Bookings are not valid until you have received confirmation from us by email. This confirmation email will contain the code to open the electric barriers at the site.

The maximum vehicle length allowed is 8.5 metres.

No towing caravans or trailers allowed.

Payment must be made in full at the time of booking for it to be valid.

Check-in and departure

Check-in is available from 2 pm.

Check-out is by 11.30 am.

Pitches must be left clean and tidy. Additional charges may apply for the removal of litter, waste, or any form of contamination that you leave on the site.

Pitches

Please note that pitch numbers are issued at the time of booking.

Our pitches are numbered and clearly marked. You must use the pitch that has been allocated to you.

If your equipment encroaches onto adjacent pitches, you will be asked to remove it.

Each pitch has a dedicated electrical socket which is numbered to match the pitch. It is forbidden to use a socket unless it has the same number as the pitch for which you have paid.

Each pitch has an adjacent hardstanding private awning area. Vehicles must never park over this area.

No tents allowed.

Vehicle safety

The maximum permitted speed for any vehicle on the site is 5mph.

Pedestrians always have the right of way on-site.

Drivers must be constantly vigilant for the movement of pedestrians, particularly when reversing vehicles.

No driving or parking over verges, footpaths or awning areas as these are not designed to carry the weight of road vehicles. The drivers of vehicles that encroach onto these surfaces will be liable for the full cost or recovery of the vehicle (if needed) and the full cost of restoring the surface to its original condition.

Fire safety

Campfires or barbecues are not permitted anywhere on the site.

Any use of naked flames is strictly prohibited, cigarettes can start a hill fire if not disposed of correctly.

In the event of fire, dial 999 and ask for the fire service. Move to the assembly point, located at the top carpark.

Respect for Others

Smoking is prohibited inside all the buildings on the site.

If your tobacco smoke is causing discomfort to others, we would ask you to move elsewhere to smoke.

Littering is strictly forbidden. This includes dropping cigarette ends which must be fully extinguished before being binned.

Domestic pets are welcome but must be always kept on a lead. Allowing pets to encroach other peoples' pitches without an invitation is prohibited.

Animal waste must be bagged and binned immediately after being dropped.

Noise should be always kept to a minimum.

Any unnecessary noise is strictly prohibited between 10 pm and 7 am.

Site rules

Exchange, transfer or sub-letting of pitches is not permitted.

Repair or servicing of vehicles on-site is prohibited, except for essential repairs to allow a vehicle to be removed from the site.

Washing of vehicles on-site is prohibited, except for cleaning the essentials for road safety.

Any criminal activity taking place on the site, or any behaviour likely to result in criminal activity on the site is prohibited and will be reported to the police.

If you leave any portable items on-site that we judge to be valuable, we will endeavour to contact you and arrange their delivery at your cost. If we are unable to contact you within a week of your departure or you refuse to pay delivery costs, we will dispose of the items.

If you leave any portable items on-site that we judge not to be valuable, we will immediately dispose of them.

You are responsible for paying the full cost of removal and storage of any vehicles or large items that you abandon on the site. Failure to pay these costs in full within 14 days of being requested to do so will result in the disposal of your property.

Liability

South Skye Motorhome Park is not liable for any loss or damage to the property of customers or any other visitor of the site including but not limited to vehicles, personal belongings, electronic devices and cash.

South Skye Motorhome Park financial liability in the event of being unable to provide a customer with adequate service shall be limited to the return of the amount of money received from the customer.

CCTV is in operation at waste disposal area to protect this equipment only.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation of an advance booking more than 15 days in advance of the arrival date will qualify for a full refund.

Cancellation of an advance booking between 7 and 15 days in advance of arrival will qualify for a 50% refund.

No refund will be made for the cancellation of an advance booking within 6 days of the arrival date.
